(f wrap at the door. It is opened by Martha. Joseph Smith and Parley P. Pratt enter.

Prophet Joseph Smith. A secret something prompted us to call at your home this evening.

Mother Knight leaves

(Vinson becons for them to be seated.) indignantly.

During this religious revival, of which you all know, I wonder much concerning the true Church. Thru the inspiration of the Lord, after battling with the powers of Satan, I found a wonderful record of the religious history of the ancient imerican Indians.

Martha. I have heard of your doctrine from my family, the McBrides, who have already accepted the gospel of Jesus Christ as you teach it.

Parley P. Pratt (handing some literature to Vinson, who arises from robe and sits and reads it.) The teachings of the newly found manuscript corresponds with the Bible, as you may note upon perusal thereof.

(Pause)

Vinson. Yes. I have just been reading one passage which correlates exactly with the Biblel

Joseph Smith. We will leave some of our literature for you to read in your leisure moments. (Hands literature to both Vinson and Martha.) Before leaving, however, I wish to bear you my solemn testimony before my Maker, the angels of heaven and you, my friends, that I know that God lives, and thru His only begotten Son, Jesus, the Christ, has restored His gospel as taught by Him personally. (Exit of Joseph Smith and Parley P. Pratt.)

Martha. Yes, dear, I am also convinced that they are the truth.

Narrator:
