

Gilbert Belnap was appointed presiding elder of the Hooper district, June 27, 1868. He fulfilled a mission in the Eastern States and Canada in 1874 and 1875. He was set apart as the first bishop of Hooper by Apostle Franklin D. Richards, May 28, 1877. His wife, Adaline was made president of the Hooper Relief Society, studied obstetrics, and spent much time administering to the sick and afflicted. His wife, Henrietta taught a small school in Hooper.
