It sits on a stand and connects to his computer with a round, pink plug that plugs into the pink outlet on the computer. Nathan bought his at WalMart for under \$10.00. Pat bought a headset with microphone attached for \$25.00 at Best Buy (\$15.00 after coupon). No software is needed, just plug the standard connector in to your computer.

Downloading SKYPE is easy from the internet. Just follow Wes's instructions from the June 8^{th} email. If too confusing, ask the younger generation to help – it doesn't take long to set up.

Welcome to Larry Julian – first time calling in. He will use a different microphone for next time as it was hard to hear him.
