Dear Mrs Martin:

I wish I didn't have to write this letter. But I must.

A while ago, I received a letter written in 1949, which contained a copy of an old statement of the names of all the children of the children of Jonas Newton Belknap. I'm now enclosing a copy of that letter. The portion of interest to you is outlined in red, on the third page. It names the children of Jonas's daughter Susanna, who was commonly called Susan or Susie in the family. As I decipher the handwriting, it reads: "Susan had 7; Arthur, Josiah, Benjamin, Jesse, Esther, Yalse (?), Aneliza." If this statement is correct, then the Susanna Belknap who married David Chatfield was not Jonas Newton Belknap's daughter.

I have delayed writing to you until I could satisfy myself about the authenticity of that statement. I am now convinced that it is completely reliable, for I'm sure I know who wrote it, though the writer is not named in that letter.

For your information, I should identify the persons named in that 1949 letter: Mrs Jane Belknap was the wife of a descendant of Jonas's son Elisha, ~~who~~ ^{was} seeking proof of that descent -- Flora Belnap, who wrote the letter, was the person who was working on the genealogy of the Mormon branch of the family -- Mrs Rhea Hardenbrook, who had the original document, is a descendant of Jonas's daughter Esther -- Mrs L N Johnson, who had copied the document and sent a copy of it to Flora is unknown to me, but can be assumed to be another descendant of Jonas. (and)

Now, the apparent reasons for believing the list of Susanna's children to be trustworthy.

(1) Among those names are ^{two} ~~names~~ which were common among Jonas's family: Jesse and Esther. (No such types of names are in the list of David Chatfield's children.)

(2) The names of children of all the other children of Jonas are correct.

(3) I am now virtually certain that the person who wrote the document that was copied by Mrs Johnson and then by Flora Belnap was Mrs Cynthia Avery of Granville, Ohio, daughter of Jonas's daughter Esther who married Samuel Carlinghouse. This Cynthia is known to have been in possession of the family Bible of Jonas Belknap and his wife Esther Parker -- and to have been in correspondence with all or most of their other descendants who were alive in the 1880's -- and to have been completely accurate in everything she wrote about them.

So now you and I are left with two questions: (1) Whose daughter was your Susanna? and (2) Whom did my Susanna marry?

Samuel

I can tell you who I think was probably the father of your Susanna -- though I can't prove it. But first I'd better recap the evidence on which, back in 1968, I identified her as daughter of Jonas. Though the evidence was wholly circumstantial, I thought it practically overwhelming -- and I'd still think so if that 1949 letter hadn't reached me.

-- Jonas's daughter Susanna was the only ^{Belknap} girl of that name known to be in Ontario County at the time of the marriage to David Chatfield.

-- her age in 1813 was 21; just normal for marriage.

-- No other Susanna (or Susan) Belknap of that or similar age was known to exist anywhere at that time.

-- Her father Jonas, in 1810, was living within about three miles of David Chatfield's father Rousel (Roswell in some records.)

-- The list of children stated by you was verified by the 1850 Census records for St Lawrence County, Ohio, which found the sons living there.

(I think)
No professional genealogist would refuse to accept such evidence. Yet it was wrong.

I now believe that the parents of your Susanna were Jonas's brother Seth Belknap and his wife Eleanor Whitney, who were living in that Ontario County area -- at Honeyoye -- in 1810. My reason for this belief is simply that Seth (though I do not know the names of his children) was apparently the only Belknap who could have been her father; and it's quite likely that he would have named a daughter Susanna, as three of his brothers and sisters did.

So I'd better tell you what I know about Seth -- though I wish I knew more, for he's the only child of Samuel Belknap and Mary Newton whose children have not yet been found in any sort of record.

His father, Samuel Belknap of Belchertown, Mass., fought beside Jonas on Bunker Hill and died in camp at Cambridge next day -- 18 June 1775.

Seth had been born at Belchertown, 19 April 1767.

On 3 May 1787 (when only 20) he married Eleanor Whitney.

At or about that time, he was given a sizable piece of farm land at Belchertown (probably by a relative of Eleanor's?).

The next year, 1788 -- when he came of age -- he sold half of that land.

He next appears 12 years later, in the 1800 Census of Cambridge, Washington County, N Y., with this listing: MALES, 1 under 10; 1 10-16; 1 26-45. FEMALES, 1 under 10; 1 10-16; 1 26-45.

Either of the two girls could have been born in the years from 1789 to 1795 and would have been of right age to marry in 1913.

One of them might well have been called Susanna -- in memory of Seth's sister Susanna who died tragically 13 April 1781 "of an apoplexia," at age 20. Three other children of Samuel and Mary named daughters for this sister -- Mary, Jonas, Stephen -- and Seth might have done so, too.

By 1810, when he was 43 years old, Seth had moved to the Honeoye area in eastern Ontario County, where Jonas had been living since 1794. This time, the Census figures give us little help. Two versions have been preserved. One of them says merely, MALES, 1 16-26; 1 Over 45; FEMALES, 1 26-45. The other version gives the same figures and adds "Three other free persons" -- who, I'm sure, were three of the youngest children of Jonas, who was at that time in process of marrying a second wife and moving to another part of the area, a bit nearer to Canandaigua.

The absence of any girls, in those 1810 Census figures, is not conclusive. The census records in that part of New York in those years were very erratic and undependable. One girl might have been missed by the census taker -- or might have been living in some other household at the moment. (The census was a census of households, not a census of families.) We are on safe ground in saying that in 1810 Seth was living within a few miles of the Chatfields and that, despite the census figures, a daughter aged about 17 or 18 and possibly named Susanna might be there with him.

My reason for being so positive about ^{other} this possibility is that I know that no other Belknap in that area (except Jonas, of course) had a daughter named Susanna. My records of the children of all Belknaps in that part of New York at that time are complete and, I'm certain, accurate -- and there is not a Susanna among them. In other words, only the Belknap whose children are unknown could have been the father of the Susanna who married David Chatfield -- and that one Belknap was Seth.

My efforts to learn the names of Seth's children have produced no results. After 1810 and before 1820, he moved about 25 miles north to theodus area on the shore of Lake Ontario, in what became Wayne County, where he remained. No will or record of intestate settlement of his estate has survived. So I have been unable to find any proof of my belief; and I can think of no further way of getting it, except to hope that by chance some day I may encounter a descendant of Seth or a record that has been preserved in some fashion.

There is, however, one small chance that I should tell you about, although I don't count on it very much. Some time ago, one of my correspondents told me about an advertisement in the May 1973 issue of The Genealogical Helper, asking for information about "parents & descendants of David Chatfield m Susanna Belknap." The advertiser was George E Cole, 76 Proctor St, Waterbury, Conn 06706. As the news of this advertisement was late in reaching me, I wrote to him offering to aid if he still needed help. He did not reply. Later, when the identification of Susanna had become a problem, I phoned him -- with no success. He didn't recall my letter but indicated that there had been "many letters" (perhaps one of them from you, I wonder!) and was only vague about Susanna. A bit later, I wrote to him again, stating my problem in full detail and asking for the names and addresses of any people who had answered his ad, so that I might contact them in search of any clue to Susanna's parentage. Still no reply. . . I've given up on him. But perhaps you might be more persuasive than I was.

I wish I could offer some better suggestions. But I've done everything I could think of; and I've run out of ideas. Sorry.

Yes indeed, you are a dear. It's just like you to volunteer to go into Wayne County to search for a Susanna who may have been a daughter of Seth Belknap.

But I don't think I should encourage your generosity in this offer. You see, that Susanna -- if she existed -- was gone from Ontario County by about 1815 or 1816 (she and her husband Chatfield moved to Ohio after the birth of their second child). So I don't believe any record of her could be found in Wayne County -- where Seth was in 1820 and 1830.

A more promising search -- mebbe -- might be to see if Seth was still in Wayne Co. census in 1840. My record of him ends with Census 1830, when he was 53 yrs old. Maybe ~~that~~ he left that area after 1830 -- and if I knew where he went I could start looking there for a will or intestate proceedings that might name his children. But if he followed Jonas to Kentucky I'd have a blind alley, for the records in the courthouses of the twp Ky counties concerned (Bart and Hardin) were burned in raids during the Civil War. And really I can't hope that anything of record in Wayne County might tell us where he went -- if he went.

I wish I felt more hopeful. My misidentification of Fern Martin's Susanna weighs on my mind. Mrs Martin had been searching for years before a stack of her inquiries came into my hands by chance. It pleased me greatly to tell that I could end her long search. Now I wish I hadn't.

Or is it just vanity? This is the only sour identification that I've made, as far as is now known. Do I merely nourish disgruntlement over this one blot on my record?

Greetings,

I received your last two communications and read them with interest. Regarding Seth I have some questions and a possible suggestion.

- 1) Wayne County was taken from Ontario and Seneca Counties in 1823, which means there might be something in Seneca County (Waterloo, county seat, 7 miles away) - or Cayuga County from which Seneca was taken in 1804 (Auburn, 26 miles away.)
- 2) I assume, from your articles, that the surrogate's records had been checked in Wayne County - "no will or record of intestate settlement of his estate has survived."
- 3) The historical association in Wayne County has an excellent index of old newspapers, according to names mentioned. My biggest find in the Mary Lat bury research was the newspaper account of the marriage of her parents in a Wayne county newspaper where I would never have thought of looking. In fact I was looking for something quite different and just happened to spy the name Lathbury.

Because of (3) I would be glad to drive over to Wayne County - only 14 miles - and check that index if you would like. They may have an early history of Sodus, or the early church records in Sodus might mention Seth - if they were Methodists.

Incidentally, when you get into the Whitney family, that's a famous old Ontario County name. In fact, there are two branches - one that came from Massachusetts and one from Connecticut. I have seen the genealogy of the one from the north, searching for the Whitney in my family without success. I have not seen the other.

I commiserate with you on the getting down to writing. I find it is much more fun doing the research. Best of luck.

Dear Carroll:

Thank you for your letter of May 13th. Looking up that census material in Ohio was no great problem. It doesn't even take much time. I am glad to do such tasks - so if you have anything more you may wish from the 1850 census of Ohio would be happy to look it up.

I do not think I have ever told you what I have found on the family of John Newton who married at Deerfield, Massachusetts on January 29, 1789, Abigail Parker. I wonder if Susannah Belknap could have married a son of John & Abigail Newton? This is only speculation of course but the following information does show a possibility.

According to "Parker in America" the children of John & Abigail were : John, Luther and Calvin (twins), Lucy and Annie. I have never found anything on any of these children except Calvin and do not know if these are the correct names for the Children of John & Abigail Newton, with the exception of Calvin. After the death of John Newton on September 20, 1839 in Decatur County (St Omer), Indiana, Abigail went to live with her son Calvin. John had lived at St Omer 13 years before his death. In 1850 Abigail Newton, then living in Rush County, Indiana applied for a Rev. War pension. She stated that her husband had lived in Massachusetts, Kentucky and Ohio before coming to Indiana. (She didn't include New York as a place of residence!)

Calvin Newton in 1850 census gives his place of birth as "New York". In 1794 John Newton executed a deed in Rensselaer County, New York, dealing with property his wife had inherited from the ^{Stiles} ~~Stiles~~. Also I believe that this was the John Newton who lived in Ontario County, New York living in 1800 near Elijah Parker at Bristol and in 1810 near Jonas Belknap also in Bristol.

These two census records of a John Newton at Bristol are shown thusly:

It could be possible that the eldest son of John & Abigail Newton was born in the early part of the 1790's and hence would be the right age to have married Susannah Belknap. Also if the John Newton of Ontario County, N.Y. was this John, brother in law of Jonas Belknap, could it be possible that children of theirs married?

Well, I do not know that the above idea helps in any way - probably just confuses the issue.

Here is the page you wanted. I am afraid that it does not carry you very much further. However, it may help some. And so may the notes about the Chatfields, which I found, and which I have also copied for you. According to the compiler, David Chatfield was married in New York 15 Aug. 1813, removed to Ohio in 1815, and Asenath was born in Lawrence County, Ohio.

Do you interpret the notes to mean that the source of the information was Miss Mary E. Chatfield, in 1900? That is what I think. She would have been 78, if she is the one in the chart, a sister to Asenath.

I hope you can decipher the copies. Please may we have another check for \$5.60? The research took about two hours. I hope you feel it was worthwhile.

In 1968, I identified as a daughter of Jonas Newton Belknap a Susannah Belknap who married David Chatfield in Ontario County NY in 1813. Though the evidence supporting the identification was wholly circumstantial, it seemed just about unchallengable -- or so I thought.

But recently, John Sherman has sent me an old letter written in 1949, which contains what amounts to a complete denial of that identification.

Since receiving that letter, I've been in touch with the source of the original data on that marriage: the New Haven Colony Historical Society. A renewed search of its files has verified the accuracy of the information the society supplied in 1968, but has produced no new information that might lead to a different identification of that Susannah, as far as I've yet been able to see.

In the hope that you may have in your files something that might help on this puzzle, I'm enclosing a summary of all the evidence yet obtained. Or perhaps your experienced mind can suggest lines of further search that I haven't thought of.

I think I should add that the list of children of Susannah and David, obtained from New Haven, seems to be unquestionably authentic on the face of it -- and is supported by other evidence obtained from one of their descendants.

The contrasting list of children, in the letter forwarded by Sherman, also seems authentic -- for it's difficult to believe that the person who wrote that list could be so right on the children of all other children of Jonas and then be completely wrong on children of Susannah.

I can supply facsimiles of all the pertinent documents if you wish to see them. But I believe the summary will be sufficient -- and will spare you the labor of deciphering old handwriting and erratic spelling.

A few days ago, a member of the staff of your Society suggested that I ask for your help on a problem that I've encountered in preparing a comprehensive Balknap genealogy.

In 1968, on the strength of unusually abundant circumstantial evidence, I identified a certain Susannah Balknap as daughter of Jonas Newton Balknap, a Revolutionary War soldier. On the basis of this identification, the D.A.R. added a new member. Now I'm embarrassed by receiving what looks like valid evidence that I made a misidentification.

The information on which I made the identification came ^{on} of a sheet naming your society as the source. I'm enclosing a copy of that sheet. If you'll look at it, I'll be most grateful.

As you'll see, the last line on the sheet says "The Socy says book ready to be published."

Can you tell me if that Sperry Genealogy has been published? If it has, I can ask NEHGS for a copy. If it has not yet been published, perhaps you can tell me what I need to know.

Assuming that the Sperry book or manuscript doesn't show the parentage or birthdate of that Susannah, the most important other detail is the place of the marriage. I have reason for believing that it occurred in what was then known as Ontario County, N.Y. -- which up to 1810 included all of that state west of Geneva Lake (more precisely, west of the Preemptianline). If I knew the place of marriage, I might then be able to trace the correct parentage.

In my predicament, any information or suggestions you can offer will be deeply appreciated.

Dear Mrs Martin:

I wish I didn't have to write this letter. But I must.

A while ago, I received a letter written in 1949, which contained a copy of an old statement of the names of all the children of the children of Jonas Newton Belknap. I'm now enclosing a copy of that letter. The portion of interest to you is outlined in red, on the third page. It names the children of Jonas's daughter Susanna, who was commonly called Susan or Susie in the family. As I decipher the handwriting, it reads: "Susan had 7: Arthur, Josiah, Benjamin, Jesse, Esther, Yalse (?), Aneliza." If this statement is correct, then the Susanna Belknap who married David Chatfield was not Jonas Newton Belknap's daughter.

I have delayed writing to you until I could satisfy myself about the authenticity of that statement. I am now convinced that it is completely reliable, for I'm sure I know who wrote it, though the writer is not named in that letter.

For your information, I should identify the persons named in that 1949 letter: Mrs Jane Belknap was ~~the descendant~~ descendant of Jonas's son Elisha, ~~who was~~ and seeking proof of that descent -- Flora Belnap, who wrote the letter, was the person who was working on the genealogy of the Mormon branch of the family -- Mrs Rhea Hardentbrook, who had the original document, is a descendant of Jonas's daughter Esther -- Mrs L N Johnson, who had copied the document and sent a copy of it to Flora is unknown to me, but can be assumed to be another descendant of Jonas.

Now, the apparent reasons for believing the list of Susanna's children to be trustworthy.

two

(1) Among those names are ~~names~~ which were common among Jonas's family: Jesse and Esther. (No such types of names are in the list of David Chatfield's children.)

(2) The names of children of all the other children of Jonas are correct.

(3) I am now virtually certain that the person who wrote the document that was copied by Mrs Johnson and then by Flora Belnap was Mrs Cynthia Avery of Granville, Ohio daughter of Jonas's daughter Esther who married Ganiel Garlinghouse. This Cynthia is known to have been in possession of the family Bible of Jonas Belknap and his wife Esther Parker -- and to have been in correspondence with all or most of their other descendants who were alive in the 1880's -- and to have been completely accurate in everything she wrote about them.

So now you and I are left with two questions: (1) Whose daughter was your Susanna? and (2) Whom did my Susanna marry?

I can tell you who I think was probably the father of your Susanna -- though I can't prove it. But first I'd better recap the evidence on which, back in 1968, I identified her as daughter of Jonas. Though the evidence was wholly circumstantial, I thought it practically overwhelming -- and I'd still think so if that 1949 letter hadn't reached me.

-- Jonas's daughter Susanna was the only girl of that name known to be in Ontario County at the time of the marriage to David Chatfield.

-- Her age in 1813 was 21; just normal for marriage.

-- No other Susanna (or Susan) Balknap of that or similar age was known to exist anywhere at that time.

-- Her father Jonas, in 1810, was living within about three miles of David Chatfield's father Rousel (Ruswell in some records.)

-- The list of children stated by you was verified by the 1850 Census records for St Lawrence County, Ohio, which found the sons living there.

No professional genealogist would refuse to accept such evidence. Yet it was wrong.

I now believe that the fathers of your Susanna were Jonas's brother Seth Balknap and his wife Eleanor Whitney, who were living in that Ontario County area -- at Honeyoye -- in 1810. My reason for this belief is simply that Seth (though I do not know the names of his children) was apparently the only Balknap who could have been her father; and it's quite likely that he would have named a daughter Susanna, as three of his brothers and sisters did.

So I'd better tell you what I know about Seth -- though I wish I knew more, for he's the only child of Samuel Balknap and Mary Newton whose children have not yet been found in any sort of record.

His father, Samuel Balknap of Belchertown, Mass., fought beside Mamas on Bunker Hill and died in camp at Cambridge next day -- 18 June 1775.

Seth had been born at Belchertown, 19 April 1767.

On 3 May 1787 (when only 20) he married Eleanor Whitney.

At or about that time, he was given a sizable piece of farm land at Belchertown (probably by a relative of Eleanor's?).

The next year, 1788 -- when he came of age -- he sold half of that land.

He next appears 12 years later, in the 1800 Census of Cambridge, Washington County, N Y., with this listing: MALES, 1 under 10; 1 10-16; 1 26-45. FEMALES, 1 under 10; 1 10-16; 1 26-45.

Either of the two girls could have been born in the years from 1789 to 1795 and would have been of right age to marry in 1813.

One of them might well have been called Susanna -- in memory of Seth's sister Susanna who died tragically 13 April 1781 "of an apoplexia," at age 20. Three other children of Samuel and Mary named daughters for this sister -- Mary, Jonas, Stephen -- and Seth might have done so, too.

By 1810, when he was 43 years old, Seth had moved to the Honeoye area in eastern Ontario County, where Jonas had been living since 1794. This time, the Census figures give us little help. Two versions have been preserved. One of them says merely, MALES, 1 16-26; 1 Over 45; FEMALES, 1 26-45. The other version gives the same figures and adds "Three other free persons" -- who, I'm sure, were three of the youngest children of Jonas, who was at that time in process of marrying a second wife and moving to another part of the area, a bit nearer to Canandaigua.

The absence of any girls, in these 1810 Census figures, is not conclusive. The census records in that part of New York in those years were very erratic and undependable. One girl might have been missed by the census taker -- or might have been living in some other household at the moment. (The census was a census of households, not a census of families.) We are on safe ground in saying that in 1810 Seth was living within a few miles of the Chatfields and that, despite the census figures, a daughter aged about 17 or 18 and possibly named Susanna might be there with him.

My reason for being so positive about ^{other} this possibility is that I know that no other Belknap in that area (except Jonas, of course) had a daughter named Susanna. My records of the children of all Belknaps in that part of New York at that time are complete and, I'm certain, accurate -- and there is not a Susanna among them. In other words, only the Belknap whose children are unknown could have been the father of the Susanna who married David Chatfield -- and that one Belknap was Seth.

My efforts to learn the names of Seth's children have produced no results. After 1810 and before 1820, he moved about 25 miles north to the Sedus area on the shore of Lake Ontario, in what became Wayne County, where he remained. No will or record of intestate settlement of his estate has survived. So I have been unable to find any proof of my belief; and I can think of no further way of getting it, except to hope that by chance some day I may encounter a descendant of Seth or a record that has been preserved in some fashion.

There is, however, one small chance that I should tell you about, although I don't count on it very much. Some time ago, one of my correspondents told me about an advertisement in the May 1973 issue of The Genealogical Helper, asking for information about "parents & descendants of David Chatfield & Susanna Belknap." The advertiser was George E Cole, 76 Proctor St, Waterbury, Conn 06706. As the news of this advertisement was late in reaching me, I wrote to him offering to aid if he still needed help. He did not reply. Later, when the identification of Susanna had become a problem, I phoned him -- with no success. He didn't recall my letter but indicated that there had been "many letters" (perhaps one of them from you, I wonder!) and was only vague about Susanna. A bit later, I wrote to him again, stating my problem in full detail and asking for the names and addresses of any people who had answered his ad, so that I might contact them in search of any clue to Susanna's parentage. Still no reply. . . I've given up on him. But perhaps you might be more persuasive than I was.

I wish I could offer some better suggestions. But I've done everything I could think of; and I've run out of ideas. Sorry.

Susannah: You asked for birthdates of children. I'm enclosing copy of original statement of children of David Chatfield and Susannah Belknap -- which has been fully vetified. Also has been confirmed by finding the male children in 1850 census of Laurence County, Ohio -- where they were supposed to be. . . But I don't think the record will be helpful, for only the first two children were born in Ontario County, which this David and Susannah left in 1816 or early 1817.

Can't give you birthdates or birthplaces of the children named by an unidentified grandchild of Jonas. Document reads just "susan had 7" followed by first names and nothing more. No surname. No dates. No places. Extremely accurate of similar lists of names of children of other children of Jonas. Hard to believe it could be so right seven times out of eight, and then completely wrong on just one.

Following up possibility that the Susannah shown as wife of Joseph Newton of Livonia might be a Susannah Belknap, I've written to County Historian, Genesee Co., asking for census 1810 and/or 1820. First test of this possibility will be ~~whether or not~~ whether or not the age bracket for Joseph's wife fits age of Susannah, born 1792. . . . I don't really hope to get any information. My guess, based on dates of recording of two deeds listed by you, is that Joseph married after 1810 and left Ontario County about 1816 -- if so, no census record there. But I have to try. . . . But suppose I do get a census record that says Joseph's wife might have been Susannah Belknap? Then what do I do? I'm hanged if I know.

Point to consider, mebbe: 1810 census, Bristol, lists girls of right ages for the two youngest daughters of Jonas: Esther and Cynthia, -- but no daughter 16-26. Was Susannah, then 18, already married? . . . Or is it just another faulty census record?

The other Susannah: Among other Belknaps in Ontario Co in 1800, Jonathan isn't worth following. He was brother of Jonas -- moved to Oswego soon after 1800 -- stayed there. I know his children; no Susannah among them. . . I'll look up the John and Jeduthan. May have names of their children.

Despite figures in 1810 census, I'm still interested in Seth. I think he was the Seth who was at Cambridge, Washington Co NY, in 1800 -- with a daughter who would be in 20's by 1810. . . I think you once sent me a record of him in census 1820, at Sodus; but can't find it in my chaotic files. . . 1830 census shows him at "Galen" in Wayne County (after Wayne was established). I've written to Surrogate, Wayne County, to see if there's a will -- or better, a record of intestate proceedings, which would name his heirs, giving married names of daughters. (Seth is almost an unknown. I have just birthdate and place; and a deed in 1788, in Belchertown, Mass. Nothing more.)

Wish me luck. I'll be grateful for help and suggestions on what else to do.

I'm deeply grateful for all the effort you put into answering my query about the possibility that Joseph Newton and his children might show up in Ohio census. But I also feel remorseful for sending you on a wild goose chase.

Actually, I had only a guess that they might have gone from Kentucky to Ohio as so many other Ontario County people did. All I really know about this Joseph Newton is this:

--- A deed to ~~Gideon Granger~~ from Joseph & Susannah Newton was recorded 1818, Ontario Co. (possibly a year or so after date of transaction).

-- This Joseph was not in Ontario County Census 1810 and 1820. From this I assume he was too young in 1810 and left Ontario Co before 1820 and thus was among the many who traded Ontario County land for some of Gideon Granger's land in Ky around 1816-1818

that I've found.

-- His wife Susannah (parentage unknown) was the only girl of that name and right probable age in Ontario County, who might have been the Susannah who was daughter of Jonas Newton Belknap, if the Susannah Belknap who married David Chatfield wasn't.

Your great aid in finding Chatfields in Ohio in 1850, and Timothy Belknap, too, let me know that you had access to these Ohio records -- so I tried it. I apologize. If they weren't in Ohio then, they might have been almost anywhere: Ky, Mich, Indiana, or even farther.

By roundabout means, a letter you wrote on August 20, 1965 has come into my hands. I think you may have addressed it to a Samuel Belknap, perhaps in Nevada. To refresh your memory, I enclose a copy of it.

I'm delighted to see that letter. For years I've been trying to find out the answer to "Whatever became of Susannah?" Now, for the first time, I have an answer. But I need to ask for more information, please.

You see, I'm a descendant of one of her brothers, Jesse Belknap -- who devoted thirty years to the task of taking his whole family, children and grandchildren and nephews, from western New York to Ohio to Iowa to Oregon, in the period from 1818 to 1848. And on foot, behind ox carts.

And I'm probably the person you meant when you wrote: "Hoping to find a Belknap with records." During the past years I have been assembling here in my study all known collections of records of the Belknap family, from 1500 to the present day. The result is that I have many thousands of pages of records covering thousands of Belknaps.

But, till now, all I've known about Susannah has been that she was born -- and the probable date of her birth.

The excuse for the rather outrageous request I'm going to make in this letter is that I'm seeking a way to do something that is not physically possible for me.

Could your office provide a list of all D.A.R. members whose Revolutionary ancestor was Sergeant Jonas Belknap, who served in the 7th Massachusetts, after first enlisting in a militia company at Belchertown, Mass.?

As the compiler of a comprehensive genealogy of the Belknap family, I am frequently asked to assist prospective members ~~with~~ the D.A.R., and I sometimes find difficulty when descent from Jonas is claimed. At the moment, my difficulties center around cases involving descent from his daughter Susannah -- but there are also other problems.

Ideally, what would be most helpful to me would be a complete copy of the line of descent of each member -- such as a Xerox copy of that portion of each accepted application.

If that's too much to ask, I could get by with a list indicating which child of Jonas is the member's ancestor or ancestress.

It appears that neither the list of the more than 100 Newton's living in Ohio in 1850 nor the above three Joseph Newton's are what you are looking for. It is possible that the one said to be the husband of Susannah Belknap had a name other than Joseph. But there are no people named Arthur, Josiah, Benjamin or Jesse listed among these Newton's in 1850 either, though it is possible that all were still residing with their parents. - For whatever value it may be to you, I am also enclosing the "Newton" names from the 4 volume index of the 1840 census. This isn't as accurate as the 1850 as quite a number of pages of this census were not readable.

Well, if there is anything else you may wish from these census indexes I would be glad to look it up. I have access to all the film of the 1850 census but not the 1840 nor do I have access to film of the 1830 census but do have to an index of the 1830 census-all of Ohio.

Your recent request for information with respect to Birth record has been received. In reply to your inquiry we wish to advise as follows:

- ☒ 1. We are sorry we are unable to find a record in this court of the nature you seek. If you have additional information which may help to establish the record you may forward same.
- ☐ 2. Your Birth record has been located in Volume page at Number in this court.
- ☐ 3. If you desire a certified copy of this record we will be pleased to forward same upon receipt of the statutory fee of one dollar. (Money Order Preferred.)
- ☐ 4. Following receipt of your enclosure of the fee of one dollar we enclose the record you have requested herewith.
- ☐ 5. Birth records with respect to births which occurred after the year 1908 are filed with the Bureau of Vital Statistics, State Office Building, Columbus, Ohio. It is suggested that you correspond with that agency in further reference to acquisition of the record you seek.
- ☐ 6. An application to correct a birth record or to obtain delayed birth registration must be made in writing to the Probate Court of the County in Ohio where the applicant was born or in which applicant now resides or in the county wherein applicant's mother resided at the time of applicant's birth.
- ☐ 7. Where it is desired to correct a birth record an application must be filed setting forth all available facts required on a certificate of birth and reasons for making the application and shall be verified by the applicant. The application must be supported by the affidavit of attending physician but if such is not available, affidavits of at least two persons having knowledge of the facts stated in the application must be supplied in lieu of physician's affidavit.
- ☐ 8. Where Delayed Birth Registration is desired, all requirements with respect to corrected birth record (see paragraph above) must be complied with. Also it is necessary for the applicant for delayed birth registration to personally appear in court with his witnesses to be examined by the Probate Judge. If personal appearance is impossible, the court may authorize the taking of depositions. It is suggested that services of an attorney should be obtained.

Dear Carroll,

Your almost constant mailing finally compelled me to use part of this very snowy day and try to clear the decks before the holidays. But first of all, let me thank you for the additional book you sent. It's delightful just to look at, and I'll enjoy reading it along with comparative parts of the others. You are certainly a most kind fellow researcher.

Yours of 11/25/69 - Thank you for the information about Amos and his family. Will file it without further ado.

Yours of 12/2 and 12/7 re: ASA NEWTON. It's a real puzzle and I haven't found much of anything so far to help. In my letter of 11/5/68, I noted some property transactions for the Vinton Family. There are some burials in Naples cemeteries which list Howard and Betsey Bryant Vinton as coming from West Hartland, Conn. This is interesting, because Abiather Newton is listed as coming from the same location in his deeds. A John Vinton of Royalton married a Sally Madison, West Bloomfield, in 1820. And one of Howard's daughters, Elizabeth, married a Granby in 1819. (George

1800 Census - shows a John Newton in Bristol, you will note, in same letter. Deeds show a transfer of property by Vine Starr of Bloomfield to John Newton, Poultney, Rutland Co., Vermont - 120 acres.

I would assume that the first Asa Newton might be the one you want. He bought property Jan. 30, 1811, in Livonia - 150 acres. Since he is not in 1810 census, he had probably just arrived. Where was he in 1810, though? Manifestly, as you point out in your second letter, Asa, Jr. is most certainly not the unnamed person in the letters of administration. And the quoted excerpts from the will certainly complicate things.

Why don't you write to the County Clerk's Office, Court House, Geneseo, New York, and ask for a Zerox copy of the will? Interestingly enough, copies of the wills are there rather than in Surrogate's office. That will give you the exact wording to work on. You might also ask them to list any other Newtons mentioned in the index of wills for 1820-1840.

I notice in the family sheet from Mrs. Marshall, there is an Oliver Newton, brother to Asa and Mary. An Oliver is listed in 1810 census in Bloomfield. Do you have any family facts?

As soon as we get a real good day, a friend and I are going to Geneseo again. I want to recheck the 1820 census, and go on to the 1830 census. I also want to particularly check for Olin if he stayed on in Ontario County for a few years as you indicate somewhere - and there are other names you have given me from time

to time. I'll see if they have anything on Niagara County, but it is pretty distant. I do have the name of the historian there and shall write.

Yours of 12/9: Re: Sarah Belknap Lincoln. I think your conclusions are quite proper. One interesting item: 1855 census, Town of Hopewell, p. 11:
Artemas Lincoln - born Otsego County, age 64 - residence in county 35 years. (probably township)
Sarah - wife - born in Penna. - age 68 - residence in county 35 years. (probably township)
Cash value of farm, \$21,450 - Stock \$1,643 - Tools-\$186

Re: The Garlinghouse Girls

I am glad you've come to a conclusion about James and his daughters. It does seem sensible. I got out your previous copy of the family listed by Mrs. Violet Belknap and studied it. Am I to assume that Silas died young, and that George, as well as Eleanor, was born after 1800 census?

Ticklish question: What are you going to do with James, Jr., listed in 1810 census, three or four doors away from the rest of them: 1-0-1-0-0 0-0-1-0-0 Poor Junior! Nobody seems to know anything about him but the census taker.

My letter of 11/17 indicated my unexpected find of another James Garlinghouse in 1810 census of Honeoye: James 0-1-0-1-0 1-0-1-0-0. He would undoubtedly be a son of John, but since he did not show up in 1800 census of John, or for himself, might he be an oldest son who followed the rest of the family to Honeoye after 1800 census?

The Josiah Garlinghouse mentioned in your letter of 11/17 is probably another son of John. We'd still need another one to complete 1800. I keep running across families in the area whose family name is Lacy. I can't find any connection.

Esther's Birthplace: Yes, ma'am. But what am I to do? I can't just say "Town of Richmond."

Problem in drafting a genealogy for present and future inhabitants of this planet: the words "Town of Richmond" mean nothing to them and can't be found on a map they are likely to see. Must indicate in some way the present name of the birthplace. As, for Jonas: Windsor, Conn. (Ellington) -- meaning that he was born in the part of the Town of Windsor that became the Town of Ellington later on and is still on the map.

On my problem with Esther, I thought I could follow your lead. In the first letter you ever wrote to me, you showed 1800 Census record of Jonas at "Honeoye." A bit later, when I learned that the Census said "Pittstown," you explained that Richmond and then Honeoye came out of what was originally Pittstown. So, trying to word Esther's birthplace so as to be intelligible to people today, I tried Richmond (Honeoye).

I'll be grateful for a helpful alternative -- please.

Reading Walbridge and Waite again and much more carefully, now that I'm thinking of more than begets and their dates, I think I've found the explanation of something I didn't understand before.

p 55: "Balknap's house stood in the present town of Richmond but he extended his claim southward into what is now the town of Springwater. . . Aaron Hunt (who had the lot just north of Jonas's lot #1; CYB) also extended his claims southward."

p. 54: ". . . the land had not yet been subdivided, no one knew how lots would be located, and hence two or more would often locate on the same lot, and for convenience often crossed the line of townships."

In other words: Jonas encroached illegally on Springwater territory; and Hunt encroached on Jonas's land. And, legally, Jonas was never in what eventually became the town of Springwater.

Another problem: Land in Bristol. Census 1810 shows Jonas in Bristol. Deed shows he sold 100 acres there in early January, that year. Hard to conceive that the census was taken in first few days of the new year. So, query. Does this indicate that Jonas owned more than those 100 acres in Bristol and kept living there after the date of that sale? Alternatively, does it mean that he continued living on those 100 acres after selling them? As no record of his purchase of land in Bristol was recorded, what's the most tenable guess?

Dear Sir:

A few years ago your office was most helpful to Miss Gladys Gray of Geneva who was aiding me in my search for information about the family of my great great grandfather Jonas Belknap, in the days when they lived near the south end of Honeoye Lake.

Now I have another problem on which, perhaps, you can help me. I'm trying to trace the marriage of Jonas's daughter Susannah; and one possibility is that she may have married Joseph Newton of Livonia, about 1810 or a few years later.

I think the simplest way to test this possibility is to see if ^{Joseph} ~~Joseph~~ Newton appears in the 1810 and/or 1820 Census, and if the age bracket for his wife fits Susannah, who was born in 1892.

I'll be most grateful if you can give me this information.

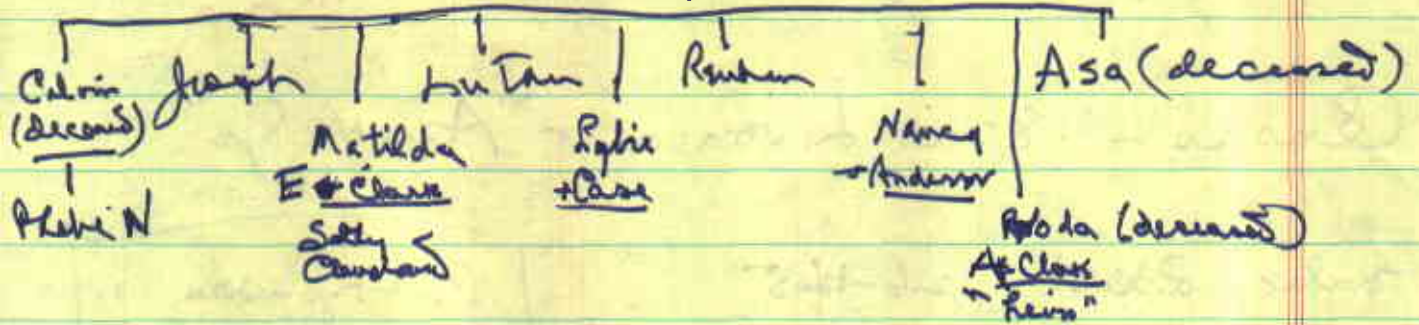

GLADYS, good friend:

It's wonderful to hear from you again. I'd been fearing you were ill. A number of times, almost phoned you to find out. But each time, I didn't -- perhaps because of silly misgivings about intrusion.

Here, I go plodding along, trying to put into organized form the mass of stuff I've accumulated in past years. Sheer drudgery. Not fun -- like the problem solving.

But right now I'm being turned aside to tackle an unavoidable problem. In 1968, on the basis of what I thought was sufficient evidence, I identified the Susannah Belknap who married David Chatfield in Ontario County as daughter of Jonas Newton Belknap and twin sister of my own great grandfather. But recently I've received old evidence, dating about 1895 or earlier, that challenges (disproves?) that identification.

When I get the story put together, I may send you a copy -- for you're the only person who might solve this perplexing puzzle, which amounts to asking "If she wasn't my Susannah, who the blazes was she."

Dear Carroll:

Enjoyed your letter of August 20th about the problem which has arisen regarding the marriage of Susannah Belknap. I went through such records as I have and find nothing that appears to have any relation to this problem.

I presume that Flora Belknap in giving the names of Susannah's children did not name a father or give a surname? It could be possible that someone in giving the list of children of Susannah confused the generations. Would it be possible that the list as given by Flora Belnap was actually the children of one of the sons of Susannah and David? It would seem possible that a reading of the 1850 census of Lawrence County, Ohio could lead to a resolution of that potentiality. I expect many of your correspondents have access to the index to the 1850 census of Ohio as well as film of this census record. If not, I would be glad to look for you. The married names of the females would be helpful in making such a search.

Regarding census records the 1810 census of Ontario County, NY, shows, living adjacent:

Roswell Chatfield	02001 - 10101
Josiah Chatfield	10100 - 00100

I guess that David was not living at home in this year as no male is shown in the proper age group to have been 24 in 1813.

I am not so sure that I can buy your statement that "In 1810 the only Belknaps in Ontario County were Jonas and his married and unmarried children; and a Seth Belknap". This is possible but it is also possible that others lived there and for some reason were not shown as heads of families in the census.

Have the Belknaps in the 1800 Ontario County census been accounted for? There were two Jonas Belknap's there then as you will recall. Was one of these Jonases another Belknap family of a different given name than that shown by the census taker? Could this possibly be the Jeduthan shown in deed records in 1805 or was Jeduthan and Jonathan the same person. There could have been a carry over into 1810 of some of these children shown in 1800 census.

Incidentally, the names I include on the enclosed sheet of Belknaps shown in deed records is not complete. The microfilm I was reading was mostly illegible in this section of the "B's". I was looking for the record, book and page number, on the deed made by Jonas Belknap of Gorham on Sept ~~14~~ 6, 1819 that you told me about long ago. I still haven't found that deed. Do you know if the deed was made or recorded on that date?

I had no particular reason for sending the enclosed census records on Belknaps. In fact you probably have most of them. But there may be an item or two of some interest to you here. - It was good to hear from you again.

Thanks a lot for your letter of the 5th. It arrived today inside an official Post Office envelope from Sacramento, with the explanation that it had been damaged by the Postal Service. Not too badly damaged -- just mangled a bit, as if caught in the gears of some machine. All still legible.

The list of Chatfields in Ohio in 1850 confirms the accuracy of my list of the children of David Chatfield and his Susannah Belknap -- same names ~~as~~ Lawrence County, where they were supposed to be. . . Aside from this, nothing yet to report on the Susannah problem.

And the detail on Vermont Belknaps in 1800 confirms my judgment on birthdate of Zedekiah, youngest brother of the Heseekiah whom I'm seeking -- many years younger than Heseekiah instead of being several years older, as shown in some records. . . Otherwise, nothing new on Heseekiah -- inquiries to date have drawn blanks.

Thanks for offering to get census details in Ohio. There's one man you could look up for me if and when it's not a bother to do so: Timothy Belknap, listed by index on page 682. If he's the Timothy who went from Cambria NY to Ohio about 1830 or a bit later, maybe the Ohio census will show name of his wife -- which even his grandchildren couldn't ~~remember~~ remember well enough to agree on it -- if she was still living in 1850. Not very important; don't make a special effort on it.

I think the simplest way to test this possibility is to see if ^{Joseph} Joseph Newton appears in the 1810 and/or 1820 Census, and if the age bracket for his wife fits Susannah, who was born in 1892.

This is just a hasty note in answer to your two recent communications. The last shall be first:

Birthplace of Esther, et al:

Your comment as to the "line" sounds logical, but your suggested alteration has one error. "Richmond (now Honeoye)" You had better omit the parenthesis, for you are mixing the "towns" in Ontario County with "villages" and, as you recall, when the historians talk about "towns" they mean townships. Honeoye was never a township, but just a village, and quite a ways north of where Esther was born. There never has been a village at that spot, so all you can say is that she was born in the Town of Richmond, Ontario County.

Oh, Susannah! Please do cry for me!

This is a real puzzler, isn't it? I will recheck my early correspondence and research to see if I can find a clue. Could I have a list of the children, with dates of birth, from both sources, please - and dates for David and Susannah? There was the John Belknap family over in Phelps in the 1800 census that apparently listed a 10-15 year old male as head of family, plus a mother and four girls. There was also Jonathan in Lima. And, of course, the early Jeduthan who bought land in Phelps in 1805 but of whom no further reference has been found. Personally, I feel - on the spur of the moment and off the top of my hat - that your initial understandings are correct but, of course, you want it settled if possible. (It - the new list - could always go in a footnote!) But I'll see what I can find.

Today was unexpectedly fine, so I took advantage of it to drive down to Honeoye again and see if I could find anyone alive who had ever heard of Garlinghouse.

I met some nice people, finally ending up in the home formerly belonging to Joseph Garlinghouse, now to the George Deal family. A grandson of Joseph, Stoughton, married a Mary Deal. These Deals were a bit young to remember hearing much, although Mr. Deal produced a small, leather-bound notebook belonging to Joseph's wife. They gave me a couple of other names that were possibilities, and then said: "Well, we can give you Nelson Garlinghouse's address. He's older than we are and might be interested." So get out your rowboat and go across the Sound to:

327 Roxbury Road, South
Garden City, South - New York
and visit your cousin! He's sort of a distant one as I try to show on the reverse side.

I went through the pages of 1810 census again and found ANOTHER James Garlinghouse, not in the settlement, but still in Honeoye - James and wife, 16-25, one son, 10-15, one daughter under 10. Must belong to John's family - since we already have a James Sr. and James Jr. I also found a Chatfield family listed in the Bristol section which has a son of marriageable age. Will try to trace further.
