

BROTHER MIDDLETON'S FAMILY.—By letter of
Gilbert Belknap, Sexton of Ogden city, we learn fur-
ther particulars of this distressed family. Sunday
morning, Jan. 30th, Joshua James died, aged 2 years
7 months, 17 days; flesh above the waist, roasted.
William died on Monday, not so badly burned, aged
5 years 7 months 22 days. Joseph M. died on Tues-
day, aged 8 years 6 months 22 days. Sister Middle-
ton, and daughter aged about 15, still survive, and
though badly burned, it is hoped that by the unremit-
ting attentions of their neighbors and friends they may
recover. Clothing and furniture were damaged, but
the house saved, we have omitted much of Brother
Belknap's letter, as it appeared in substance in our for-
