RECORD OF ARIAS GUY BELNAP
(Arias' writing)

Born Sept. 6, 1893 at Hooper, Utah-Weber County at the residence of my grandfather Gilbert Belnap.

Blessed by Hyrum Belnap, my father, Sept 14, 1893.

Aug. 23, 1900 my right leg was broken at the thigh by a fall while running from the house to the barn at 918--21st, Ogden, Utah. Confined to my bed for seven weeks, all the time I laid on my back with my leg done up in plaster paris. The bone was set by Dr. Ezra and Edward Rich.

Baptized Sept 22nd, 1901 by Elder John W. Chambers, Sr. in the Ogden River at Ogden. Confirmed by my father Sept 22, '01.

Ordained a Deacon Oct 15, 1906 by my father Hyrum Belnap in the Fourth Ward. Sept apart as president of the First Quorum of Deacons in the 4th ward Sept. 21, 1908. This position I held until ordained a Teacher Apr. 12, 1909. Ordained a Teacher by Albert E. Stratford. Recorded in the Ogden 4th Ward, Ward Record of ordinations, Book 4, No. 528.

Set apart as 1st counselor to Hyrum Sanders _____ 1909 in the Ogden 4th ward. *Teacher gr.*

Ordained an Elder Oct 12, 1913

Went on a mission to Germany Nov. 6, 1913.

Returned to the U. S. because of the war and was assigned to Southern States Mission, Georgia. Returned Feb. 15 1916.

Worked in the Hyrum Belnap Lumber yard until July 29, 1918 when he left for Goat Island, California--in the civil service of the U. S.

He married Mabel Harris on Sep. 20, 1916.
