Dear Brother

I received your kind and ever  
welcome letter was glad to hear  
from you I hope you have  
come out all right with your  
Discussion which I think you  
have the folks are all well  
except Fenerill she has not  
been very well for some time  
Eliza has got a fine little girl  
Franks boy has been very sick  
but is better now Oliver is  
living in Ogden We had a  
visit from the superintendant  
of the Sunday Schools of the  
Territory on the 26 and on the  
next day a visit from  
President John Taylor George I  
Conner and others we had a

very good time I was glad to  
get to shake hands with the  
President of the Church  
The paper that you wanted me  
to send has been torn up but  
I send the letter inclosed in this  
The crops is about as usual half  
burnt up for the want of water  
The wether has been very  
changable very hot at times  
and cool at others there was  
a little frost the other night  
we have commenced harvesting  
Father is at home he has been  
to the Canyon and got a load  
of poles we did not have  
much on the ~~fourth~~ some  
horse races Nills mare got  
away with anything that  
come along she run with  
The Joneses mare and come out  
~~the~~ foot and a half ahead they  
run 250 yards there was

others but they was not quit  
so fast as them there was  
a foot race between R Howard  
and G Wardsmith they run  
a 100 yards and the latter  
beat we had some fun and  
and a fight that was not  
much fun the fighters but  
for the by standers they  
did not hurt one another  
much they was G Wardsmith  
William Hardy Jr they  
did not have any thing in  
Ogden on account of the  
President Garfield getting  
shot we have got lots  
of fruit this year the  
wind blows a good deal  
of the time I guess this is  
all at this time
