To all who shall see these presents, Greeting:

Know Ye, That whereas, Hyrum Belnap was, on the Fourth day of August A. D. 1884, duly elected Assessor and Collector in and for Weber County, and he having duly qualified as such, as appears by the proper evidence on file in the Office of the Secretary of the Territory,

Therefore, I, Elo H Murray Governor of said Territory, do hereby commission him as such Assessor and Collector for said County and authorize and empower him to discharge the duties of said Office according to law, and to enjoy the rights and emoluments thereunto legally appertaining, for the term prescribed by law, and until his successor shall be elected and qualified to office!

In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said Territory to be affixed.

Done at Salt Lake City, this Third day of January A. D. 1885, and of the Independence of the United States the One Hundred and Ninety
