

Hillmore Dec 6th 1887

Dear Sister Martha

I will write you a few lines
I am very anxious to hear
how you and the rest of
our folks are getting a long
in the work for the Redemption
of our relatives who have
passed behind the veil
that is my greatest enjoyment
realising our days are fast
being numbered tell all
of our folks to hurry up for
we do not know soon the
Temples may be closed again
us as a people (st)

I want to know if Featherin
Felslow Newton's wife has
been Endowed for and if they
have been sealed she that was
Julia Felslow is going to the
Manti Temple in the Spring
and will tend to it if it is
not done up there
my health is very poor

but I cannot expect other wise
I have lived the longest of any
of our Fathers mainly except
Samuel he was a little older
than me were is Henrietta I
heard she had moved North
tell James and Gilbert or any
of our folks to write it does
me so ^{much} good ~~to~~ to here from
there I would like to see you
once more and would if I

had means and health ^{by name of Irish}
there was a Elder here and
preached last Sunday from
Hyrum said he was well
acquainted with the McKrides
there they were greatly taken
up with his preaching

give my respects to all our
folks write as soon as you
get this God Bless you
