COUNTY CONVENTION.

The Proceedings Harmonious and Expeditions.

The delegates from the several precincts of Weber County assembled in the Court House, Ogden, July 26th, 1879, at 2 o'clock.

Edwin Stratford, Esq., was chosen chairman, and James Taylor Secretary of the meeting.

The chair appointed the following named gentlemen a committee on credentials—Winslow Farr, of Ogden; Wm. Geddes, of Plain City; Josiah Ferrin, of Eden.

The committee reported the following delegates entitled to seats—Edwin Stratford, Robert McQuarrie, Winslow Farr and James Taylor, Ogden precinct; Josiah M. Ferrin, Eden; Wm. Geddes, Plain City; P. G. Taylor, Harrisville; Sanford Bingham, Riverdale; Thomas Saulsbury, Marriott; Amos B. Corey, Uinta; Thomas Hartly, West Weber; F. A. Hammond, Huntsville; Joseph Harrop, Lynne; John A. Alfred, Slaterville; Thomas J. Wilson, Wilson; H. W. Manning, Hooper.

The report was accepted and the committee discharged.

A motion was made that the chair appoint a committee on nominations. After some debate the motion was carried, and Sanford Bingham, Robert McQuarrie and John A. Alfred were appointed said committee, who retired.

The chairman was called upon for a speech. In response he said that men should be elected to office who would labor for the general good, and not entertain sectional feelings. He referred to the many public improvements that were necessary in the city and county, and favored a united effort for their consummation.

The committee returned and reported the following ticket:

The report was received and the committee discharged.

A motion was made and carried that the nominees be presented separately for acceptance.

Each candidate was presented and sustained by a large majority.

The minutes were ordered to be printed in the Ogden Junction. The chairman and secretary each received a vote of thanks.
