

THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

County Attorney Asks for Additional Counsel,

And Gets It—The Two Tax Cases Cause the Request—Other Matters—Large Number of Bills.

The Board of County Commissioners met yesterday and rushed business through. Among the important matters was the granting of authority to the county attorney to employ additional counsel in the two tax cases which were recently begun against Treasurer Chambers by the Commercial National and the Utah National banks.

THE SESSION.

The board met at 10 a. m., all members being present. Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Commissioner Hammon reported matters at poor farm unchanged. Also that road trouble at Taylor and West Weber had been investigated. The road in question was opened on lines established by Surveyor Bethel and also by survey of County Surveyor Bostaph and the matter is settled. Report accepted and commissioner given farther time in which to report on other road matters.

Relative to the widening of the channel in the South Fork river Chairman Armstrong reported that county surveyor had not yet reported.

Reported that W. F. St. John was admitted to the hospital Friday.

Commissioner Hammon reported Cottle and Parker bridges completed and satisfactory.

Report of county surveyor as to Warren bridge filed.

On motion of Commissioner Seaman claim of C. J. A. Lindquist of \$33.50 for burial of poor girl was disallowed.

On motion it was ordered that an appropriation of \$30 be made to Mrs. Carl Anderson on account of expense of illness of indigent girl.

Report of Fruit Tree Inspector Fowler read and ordered filed.

Report of county physician read and filed.

Request of Peter A. Mateson for quit claim deed to southeast quarter of section 34, township 6, range 2 west, 25 acres, granted on payment of taxes, costs and interest on same.
