

# DEATHS

Charles Warner died Wednesday, November 28, at his home in Cheyenne, Wyo. Mr. Warner was an employe of the U. P. railroad, having been employed in Cheyenne for the past 26 years. Before going to Wyoming Mr. Warner lived in Uintah. He was well known in Ogden among railroad men. Surviving are his widow and one daughter, one brother and three sisters. The body will arrive in Ogden tomorrow morning at 8 o'clock and will be taken to the Lindquist undertaking parlors. The funeral cortege will leave the funeral parlors at 10 a. m. for the City cemetery, where interment will be made.
