

## FUNERALS

Final rites for Billa J Cheney were held Tuesday at 1 o'clock in the Thirteenth ward meeting house. Bishop J Howard Jenkins of that ward presided. Twelve members of the Ogden fire department acted as pallbearers and honorary pallbearers. Members of the Ward Relief society and Mutuals carried the flowers. "Rock of Ages" and "Oh My Father" were sung by Mrs. Mary Farley. "I Need Thee Every Hour" and "One Sweetly Solemn Thought" were sung by Jay Taggart.
