

RULON GARFIELD

'All Faces' Executive **Appointed**

The 12th annual performance of Roland Perry's musical drama. "All Faces West," will hit the stage at the Fourth Street Pioneer Park July 20, 21 and 22.

Stanley Brewer, newly elected president of the board of directors, also announced today that Rulon Garfield, Ogden educator, is the new executive manager of the show, replacing Gordon Belnap. Mr. Belnap was manager of the drama during its highly successful run last vear.

Lynn Baker, Weber County treasurer, was elected treasurer of the group and Joseph F. Breeze was named vice president of the board.

In accepting Mr. Belnap's resignation the board commended him for his efforts. Last year was the most successful in the musical's

history. Mr. Garfield was selected to replace him because of his "active work in civic affairs and his wide executive background," Mr. Brewer

Mr. Garfield is principal of the Bonneville Elementary School and has served on many community programs in health and education. He has authority to proceed with the production immediately, Mr. Brewer said. He is directly responsible to the board of directors.

No selections of committee heads have yet been made, Mr. Garfield said. Plans for this year's performance will include a change of format, he indicated.

This would probably be a return to the music-narration of earlier shows. Last year's dialogue-musical situation was criticized in some

In keeping with the improved financial status of the "All Faces West" pageant the show late last year returned \$1,000 to Ogden City to be used to foster improvements in the park area which the show calls "home."

Work is moving rapidly to select production personnel for the pa-geant, Mr. Garfield said.


He admitted buying a cough syrup containing codeine at an amount exceeding the legal limit.




