I Thomas Bortell of Spils Terran Church Lane in the parish of Saint
George in the East in the County of Middlesex Carpenter being weak in
Body but of sound and disposing mind memory and Understanding
knowing as given to Almighty God for the same to make and publish this
my last will and Testament in manner following that is to say first and
principally I recommend my Soul to God that gave it my Body I
commit to the Earth to be truly interred at the direction of my next
Executors hereinafter named and as to my worldly Estate which it
shall please God to bestow on me I give and dispose thereof as follows
that is to say after payment of all my just debts funeral Expenses and the
Expenses of proving this my will I Give and bequeath unto my son Samuel
Bortell all that my two Leasholds Messuages or Tenements and premises
situate in ^{St. Dunstons} Street Stepney Green in the County of Middlesex and
numbered 1 and 2 To have the same unto the said Samuel Bortell his
Executors Administrators and Assigns for and during all the term years
and continuance of the term which shall be then to come and unexpired or
heroin subject to the payment of the rent and performance of the
Covenants provisions and agreements therein mentioned and contained
also I Give and bequeath unto my daughter Amelia Bortell all
that my two Leasholds Messuages or Tenements and premises which
is situated in Silver Street Stepney Green aforesaid and numbered
3 and the other is situate in Brilliant Street in the Strand of White and
old Town in the County of Middlesex and numbered 9 To have the same
unto the said Amelia Bortell her Executors Administrators and Assigns
for and during all the term years and continuance of the said term which
shall be then to come and unexpired heroin subject to the payment
of the rent and performance of the Covenants provisions and
agreements therein contained I Give and bequeath unto my son
Thomas Bortell the sum of five hundred pounds I Give also
bequeath unto my said daughter Amelia Bortell all my plate
and China standing and being in and about the premises heroin
I now dwell I Give and bequeath unto my said daughter Amelia
Bortell and my said son Samuel Bortell all my household
furniture linen and all and every such other matters and things as
shall or may be standing and being in and about my said house and
premises in Spils Terran aforesaid also all such sum and sums of
money and securities for money of what nature or kind the same may
be and consist of at the time of my decease together with all such debts
or debts as shall or may be due and owing unto me in any manner
at the time of my decease to be equally divided between them All
the rest residue and remainder of my personal Estate and effects of
what nature kind or quality the same may be and consist of at the
time of my decease and which I may be possessed of or entitled unto not
excepted before I dispose of I give and bequeath the same and every part
thereof unto my said daughter Amelia Bortell and my said son
Samuel Bortell and lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and
appoint Henry Wilson of Spils Terran aforesaid Barber and John
Cook of Cockfouwell Close in the County of Middlesex Gentleman Executors
of this my last will and Testament every by writing and making void all
former and other will or wills by me at any time heretofore made
ratifying and allowing and confirming this to be my only true last

Will and Testament in witness whereof I the said Thomas Dornell have to this my last will and Testament contained in two sheets of paper to the first sheet set my hand and to the last my hand and seal this thirteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven - *T. Dornell* Es. Signed Sealed published and declared by the above named Testator Thomas Dornell as and for his last will and Testament in the presence of us who were in his presence and at his request and in the presence of each other have subscribed our names as witnesses hereto - *Thos Dalton* Union Street Bishopsgate - *John Chesney*

On the 10th April 1812 a man (with the will annexed) of the Goods of Thomas Dornell late of Spitz Court Court Lane in the parish of St George in the County of Middlesex died was granted to Amelia Dornell Sp^{ce} the said one of the ordinary Legatees named in the said will bearing her first sworn only to administer Henry Wilson and John Cook the Executors bearing first oaths //

Daniel Bellnap

Daniel Bellnap In the parish of Saint John Starkway in the County of Middlesex doth will and bequeath to my wife Susanna Bellnap the whole of my property consisting of money in the Bank Book Debt Share of my S^{ave} Stock in Trade and every Article belonging to me Signed *Daniel Bellnap* April 17 1802 Witness *Wm Wilson* *John Harvey*

On the 10th April 1812 a man (with the will annexed) of the Goods of Daniel Bellnap deceased the Robert Universal Legatee to whom a man was granted bearing her first late of Adoniston in the parish of St John Starkway in the County of Middlesex died was granted to Susanna Bellnap widow the Robert Universal Legatee bearing her first sworn only to administer no Executor being named //

In the Name of God Amen I John Binsley late of Montague Street Spitalfields ffices Gentleman but now of the Skinners Alley and Great Saint Martin Bishopsgate Street London do hereby publish and declare this to be my last will and Testament as follows I humbly resign my soul to almighty God hoping for mercy and salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ after payment of all my just debts funeral and testamentary Expenses bequeath all my money in the public funds and all other my Estate and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever unto my my Executor and Executors hereinafter named upon trust to pay apply and transfer the whole of the Duties Dividends and principal thereof unto or to the use of my daughter Mary Slatter wife of Henry Slatter from time to time in such manner and for such purposes as she shall think proper notwithstanding ever Contrivance or contrivance of her Husband first from his power Contract Debt or Engagements for her own sole and separate benefit and for which her receipts alone shall be sufficient discharges and do hereby appoint my Cousin John Pool of Blaxwell Hall London Gentleman Elizabeth Pool his wife and Mary Chappell of Blaxwell Hall London the Widow Executor and Executives of this will and do hereby revoke all former wills in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this ninth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight - *John Binsley* Es.
