 and all other moneys and things whatsoever whith now and at any time
 hereafter is and shall be due to me for my wages service or otherwise
 in any of their Majesties Shippes friggetts or vessels or any merchant
 shipp or shippes as alsoe to demand receive and receive of all other
 person and persons whatsoever whome it doth or may concerne All
 and singular such other summes and summes of money goods wares effects
 wages debts dues clamours and demands whatsoever whith now and
 hereafter is or shall be due and payable unto me either by bond bill
 booke attempt or otherwise howsoever And moreover in my name and

 the uncertainty of this transitory life doe make and declare these
 presents to containe my last Will and Testament that is to say all
 and singular such wages summe and summes of money lands tenements
 goods chattells and Estate whatsoever wherewith at the time of my
 decease I shall be possessed or invested or which shall then belong or
 of right appertain unto me I doe give devise and bequeath unto
 Wrary Dingham my well beloved friend and I doe hereby nominate
 and appoint the said Wrary Dingham my true and lawfull Attorney
 of this my last Will and doe revoke all former Wills and deeds of a
 gift by me at any time heretofore made and doe ordaine these
 presents to stand and be for and as my only last Will and Testament
 In witness whereof I have herunto sett my hand and seal the
 nineteenth day of Aprill Anno Domini one thousand six hundred ninety
