Coal Future For Utah: 'It's Bright'

ties of the western states presented more actual cost savings than were inherent in EHV transmission, coal-slurry routing or development of integral or unit-train approach by railroads.

NONE OF THE speakers presented any doubts that Utah, with billions of tons of coal reserves, could meet the supply issue. The preemption and dedication of sites for power plants, water use and coal reserves was another question.

Mr. Reichl asserted that the 110-mile coal-slurry pipeline operated by Consolidation Coal Co. was closed down as a result of new contracts negotiated between eastern railroads and electric utility coal consumers.

HE EMPHASIZED that Consolidation was first a coal selling company and secondly a coal-slurry pipeline oriented firm.

THE VICE president of one of the largest coal firms in the United States told the engineering audience that coal-slurry pipe line coal could be delivered to Southern California so as to produce energy in range of four to five mills or equal to 30 cents per million BTU contained in natural gas.

MR. REICHL said that neither "legal" water supply nor other problems were a bar to development of the coal pipeline concept to southern California.

THE SOLUTION: location of coal-burning steam electric plants 50-to-75 miles from population centers, as is now the plan for nuclear reactor power stations in the great California market centers for energy.

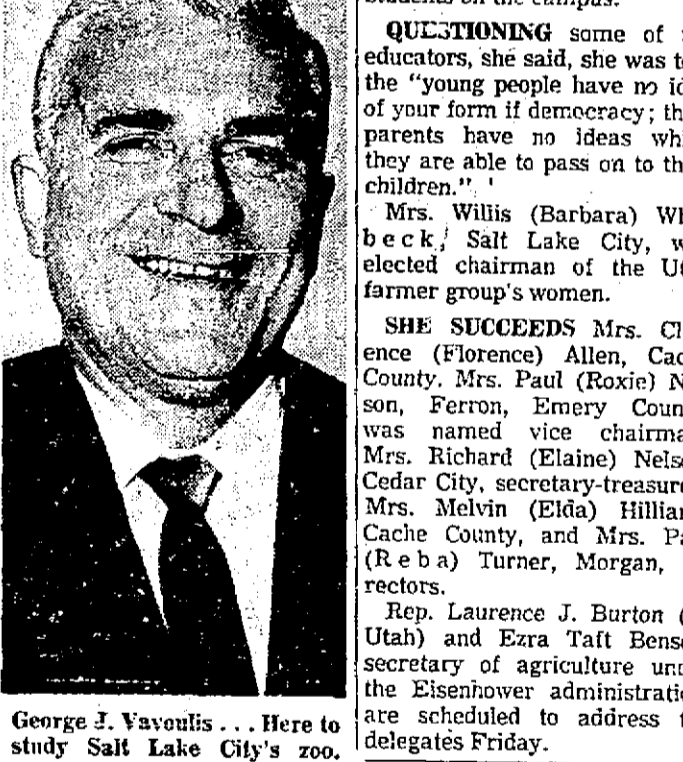
