

Jury Lists Guilt For Banker

OGDEN (AP) — A federal court jury found former Commercial Security Bank Vice President Gordon Belnap guilty on one count of misappropriating bank funds and innocent on another Friday night. The verdict came after four hours of deliberation. Sentencing was set for Dec. 15 in U.S. District Court in Salt Lake City. The jury found Belnap innocent of embezzling \$13,200 but found him guilty of depositing in his own account a \$5,000 cashier's check from Commercial Security made out to a bank in Pennsylvania. "The maximum sentence for the conviction is five years in prison and a \$5,000 fine. Belnap said following the guilty portion of the verdict, "It certainly is not true." He said he would have to consult his lawyers before deciding on an appeal.

Writer Wins Award

SAN FRANCISCO — A feature article on The Rolling Stones musical group has won a \$200 prize for Fred S. Kempe, 2990 E. 3900 South, Salt Lake County, in the October news writing competition of the William Randolph Hearst Foundation's Journalism Awards Program. Mr. Kempe is a University of Utah journalism major and a copy editor at The Salt Lake Tribune. The article appeared in The Tribune's Arts Section on July 20. Top award and \$1,200 went to David Steven Smith of the University of Florida. Mr. Kempe won two Hearst citations last year for stories published by The Tribune.

Brigham Plans Review in Library Issue

BRIGHAM CITY (AP) — The city council, after facing an overflow crowd carrying protest signs and placards, has voted unanimously to review the firing of city librarian Fern Tovey. Mayor Harold B. Fell said the council had no legal responsibility to review the firing and he read from the city code, which gives the library board the exclusive right to hire and fire library personnel. The board had fired Miss Tovey. But, an attorney for the Utah Public Employees Assn. told the city council that state law does not give that absolute power to library boards. He said the council had moral and ethical

responsibilities to hear the review and the appeal. Miss Tovey was fired Monday at a 10-minute board meeting for what the board called a "lack of communication" and an inability to meet administrative requirements of the board. The action aroused public protest and more than 100 people attended the council meeting. Some carried placards calling for her reinstatement.
