left this place on or about the 26th of Nov with a load of Oats for me to be delivered to Eldridge & Clowson in G G City with an agreement to return immediately with bill of goods from E & C and a load of Salt from the Lake Shore, he hired a horse from me for the trip I have not heard from him since I expect he is playing a game with me I wish you to make inquiries and take such steps in the matter as may be necessary. If he has sold the Oats, drawn the goods from E & C, bought a load of Salt on my credit and struck for Virginia City with Salt @ 81.40 per lb. he will make a very good thing I shall be down in a few days in the mean time what you may think necessary in premises
