of all most committed to memory that it seems that never have I received money letters but never have I received one that I think so much delight in Ourselves if I could only be you one more it seems that I should almost include all the handwriting that I have of the miscellaneous country that I have collected no on first of these persons the Lord desire had about 2 years that

once putting an end will be no more of that for I had take last fall had some things to buy up in the house with the leaves says that the time I got out for at least I had got to let me in the season to work

The friends of I give up the journey to the spring never will make take it again I have only just arrived from Kentucky Indiana where I have been a long time of the winter
