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
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



PREFACE.

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THE Editor has to regret, in common with all Members of the Society, the loss which has been sustained by the death of his friend and co-Editor the late Colonel CHESTER. The delay in the issue of this Volume was due to the serious illness of the wood-engraver, and it was thought undesirable by the Council to put the work into other hands so long as there was a reasonable prospect of Mr. CLEGHOBN's convalescence. The whole work has now been completed, and the present volume forms the Publication of the Society for the year 1883.

Bules.

1. This Society shall be called the HARLEIAN SOCIETY.

2. It shall have for its chief object the publication of the Heraldic Visitations of Counties, and any manuscripts relating to Genealogy, Family History, and Heraldry, selected by the Council.

3. The Council shall consist of a President, nine Vice-Presidents, and twelve Members of Council, two of whom shall hold the posts of Secretary and Treasurer; and any four, including the Treasurer or Secretary, shall' form a quorum. In case of equality of votes, the Chairman to have a casting vote. Any Candidate may be elected with the consent in writing of one Member of the Council, the Treasurer, and the Secretary.

4. Three Members of the Council shall retire in rotation annually, but shall be eligible for re-election.

5. The Annual Subscription shall be One Guinea, paid in advance, and due on the 1st day of January in each year; and new Members shall pay an Entrance Fee of 10s. 6d. in addition to their first Annual Subscription.

6. Members may at their option subscribe Two Guineas per annum, in which case they will be entitled to the publications of the Register Section of the Society.

7. The funds raised by the Society shall be expended in publishing such works as are selected by the Council; but no payment in money shall be made to any person for editing any work for the Society.

8. One volume at least shall be supplied to the Members every year.

9. An Annual Meeting shall be held in the month of January every year, at such time and place as the Council may direct; and due notice shall be sent to the Members of the Society at least a fortnight previously.

10. No work shall be supplied to any Member unless his Subscription for the year be paid; and any Member not having paid his Subscription for two years, having received notice thereof, shall cease to belong to the Society.

11. No copies of the publications of the Society shall be supplied to persons not actually Members, and each Member shall be restricted to a single Subscription.

12. An account of the receipts and expenses of the Society to be made up to the 31st of December in each year, and published with a list of the Members and the Rules of the Society in the following Volume.

13. These Rules shall not be altered except at the Annual Meeting, and three clear weeks' notice must be given to the Secretary of any such intended alteration,

Report for the Pear 1882.

DUBING the year nineteen Members have joined the Society, six have resigned, nine have died, and eight have been removed under Rule X.

The "Visitation of Cheshire in 1580," edited by J. PAUL RYLANDS, Esq., F.S.A., has been issued during the year.

The Register Section has issued the "Registers of St. Michael, Cornhill."

During the progress of the latter work through the press the Council lost the services of their most valued colleague, Colonel JOSEPH LEMUEL CHESTER, D.C.L., LL.D. He was one of the Founders of the Society, and the Council cannot allow this opportunity to pass without putting on record their expression of opinion of the sad loss the Society has sustained by his death.

The Second Volume of "The Visitation of London" has been delayed through the constant illness of the Engraver, but more rapid progress is now being made, and it is hoped that it will be issued this year.

Sir JOHN MACLEAN and Mr. J. C. HEANE have the "Gloucestershire Visitation" in hand, and ready for the press; Mr. BLAYDES is preparing the "Bedfordshire Visitation;" and Captain WHITE is making progress with "The Durham Cathedral Registers." Mr. BYLANDS has kindly undertaken to edit the "Visitations of Dorsetshire and Shropshire;" and other Volumes are on the List of Prospective Publications.

The Publication of the Register Section now being printed is "St. Antholin, Budge Row, and St. John Baptist on Wallbrook, London."

The Accounts are appended to this Report, and it is hoped they will meet with the approval of the Members.

His Grace the DUKE OF WESTMINSTER having joined the Society during the past year, has consented to become a Vice-President in the place of Sir GEORGE DUCKETT, who has resigned.

Mr. THOMAS BROOKE, F.S.A., the Chairman of the Council of the Yorkshire Archæological Association, has been elected on the Council in the place of the late Colonel CHESTER, and Capt. E. A. WHITE, F.S.A., in the place of the late Mr. J. B. DANIEL-TYSSEN.

The Retiring Members of Council are Mr. AMHERST, Dr. MARSHALL, and Mr. RYLANDS. They offer themselves for re-election.



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Report for the Pear 1883.

TWENTY-NINE Members have joined the Society during the past year; eight have resigned; seven have died; and the names of nine Members have been removed under Rule X. The present number on the Roll is three hundred and eighty, of whom one hundred and eighty-four are subscribers to the Register Section of the Society.

It is with great regret the Council have to state that the continued illness of Mr. Cleghorn, the Engraver, has so long delayed the publication of the Second Volume of the "Visitation of London;" but as it is so nearly complete (the pedigrees of families beginning with the letter W being now in the press), they consider it is not advisable to employ another Engraver.

The printing of the "Visitation of Gloucestershire" has also been delayed through unforeseen circumstances, both Editors having been unable from different causes to proceed with the correction of the proofs as rapidly as was anticipated; but good progress is now being made.

The "Visitations of Bedfordshire" are now also in the Printers' hands.

The "Visitation of Shropshire" is in the Transcriber's hands.

The Register Section has printed the "Registers of St. Antholin, Budge Row, and St. John Baptist on Wallbrook, London."

The "Registers of St. James, Clerkenwell, London," are in the press, and the "Registers of Christ Church, Newgate Street, London," are now being transcribed.

The Accounts are appended to this Report, as usual.

A fire broke out at the Binder's in February last, when some portion of the Society's stock of Register Publications was destroyed. The stock was, however, insured, and the amount paid by the Fire Office (\pounds 150) has been placed to the Society's credit.
