In the name of God Amen The eight and twentieth daye of
January in the yeare of o^r lorde god One thousand fyve hundred Ninety Nime I Josias Belknap
in the parish of S^t Bridgouth in the countie of Lincolne here do make thys my last will and
testament in the manner and fourme followinge (That is to say) First I bequeath my soule
to the Almighty god my only savior and redeemer in whome and by the merites of whose moste
glorious death and precious blood I shewd my only trust is to have remission of my synnes
and to be saved Item I bequeath my body to the earth from whence yf did come and as touching
the disposicion of my goodes I geve unto my brother Bennet Belknappe my lande and I geve
him more Twenty poundes of money whereof he oweth me five poundes for three yeares
rent for my lande and he oweth me more for one yeare fyve poundes five shillings eight
pence and I lent him more seven poundes the Twentye fyve daie of January in the yere
abovenaied y^e is all due to me at the feaste of S^t Michaelmas daie nexte comynge In
the yeare of o^r lorde god One thousand six hundred and I geve him those goodes and legacies w^{ch}
my fath^r left me and I geve him that linnen and houshoude stuffe w^{ch} he hath of myne in
his keepynge I geve him all my apparell but one blacke suite and one blacke cloke Item I
give to my sosen John Browne in Southwarke Twenty poundes and I geve to fore his
wyfe Twenty Nobles I give him my white Coler and all suche linnen as I have in his house
I geve him out suet of blacke and one blacke Cloke I geve him more one Band of Duell
sheltons to the some of Ten poundes I geve him one Bill of William Shelton to the some
of Ten poundes and I geve him all my small Willees and Bondes and all suche debts ad
maie be gotten opp in Keeland and I geve to his s^rvante Amos Twenty shillings and
I give to the poore in S^t Bridgouth Forty shillings to be distributed as my Executor shall
see good and lykewise there is due unto me oppon a retaine arrounys Forty poundes that
being received I geve to my broth^r Ralfe Browne fyve poundes I geve to my broth^r Robert
fyve poundes and I geve more to my sosen John Ten poundes and I geve to the poore
where I shalbe buried Twenty shillings to be dealt as my overseer shall see good and I give
more to the poore in S^t Bridgouth Forty shillings and I geve to my syster Marie Bryde
widowe fyve poundes and I geve to M^{rs} Frammes Shelton foret a miggello to make her
a Kinge and all the rest after my funerals be discharged I give to my broth^r Bennet
Belknappe and I make my broth^r Bennet Belknappe my full executor and I make my
sosen John Browne my overseer Josias Belknappe the marke of Frammes Bradswells

In the name of God Amen
I Sampson Hunt of Crayford
in Kent beinge sicke in bodie but of good and perfect remembrance thank be given to god doe
make this my last will and testament And firste I doe make my humble and hartie prayer unto
Almightie god by whose death and passion I only trust to be saved and redeemed from all my sinnes
That he of his great and fatherly mercie will contynue his love and favo^r towards me unto the
last ende My will is if it please god to call me unto his mercie out of this vaine and transitory
worlde that then my bodie to be buried in the church of Crayford and for those goodes wherewith
with it hath pleased his gracions favo^r to blesse me wth all my will and desire is that there be
given unto the poore people of Crayford the some of twenty shillings and I doe bequeathe
unto my sonne Richard Hunt the some of two hundred p^oundes of lawfull money of England
to be payde to my said sonne when he shall attomplishe the age of twenty and one yere and
in the meane tyme to be brought upp and kepte at schoole where by he maie be fitt if of please
god to send him lyfe to be put forth to be a p^orentise in London of some good honest Trade by the
advise of his mother and my Overseers or the more parte of them that shall be then livinge as they
shall thinke it fitt for him and that my wife wth their advise and counsell of my Overseers put
forth the said two hundred p^oundes to the best use and profite for the better maintenance and
defrayinge the charge of his bringinge upp. Item I will bequeathe to Anne Hunt my eldest
Daughter the some of fifty p^oundes of lawfull money of England and unto my daughter Marthe
other some of fifty p^oundes and unto Marye my daughter the some of other fifty p^oundes of
lawfull money of England to be payde to my said daughters at the tyme of their marriages or at
the age of eightene yeres wth they shall first attomplishe and if it fortune that anye of them
dye before they be married or shall attomplishe the said age that then her portion that shall
dye to be devyded equallye amongst the other that shall survive and if yt fortune that theye all dy
that then my will is their portions to come unto their brother Richard Hunt but if yt happen my
sonne Richard to dye afore he shall attomplishe the full age of one and twenty yeres then my
will is that the two hundred p^oundes heretofore bequeathed unto him shall be equallye devyded
in to fower parts wherof my welbeloued wyfe to have fifty p^oundes and each of my daughter
fifty p^oundes a peere or if any of them be deade at that tyme then equallye to be devyded among
the Survivors that shall be then livinge. Provided that my said daughters when they come to
age of marriage that in their choise of their husbands they be advysed and ruled by their
mother and by my Overseers so that they marrie not wthout their goodwill and privitye of the
mother or the most parte of my Overseers. Item I will and give unto my wyfe Margerett Hunt
duringe her naturall lyfe to be payde unto her yearlye by my Executor the some of thirtene shillings
fower pence to be payde unto her quarterlye by such portions. Item my will is that my welbeloued
wyfe shall have and enjoye to the bringinge upp of my children the use and profite of all their
said portions so longe as she shall kepe her selfe unmarried but if yt shall chaunce that she dothe
marrye that then one moneth after she shall be so married she together wth him whom she shall
marrye wth one other sufficient suretye such as my Overseers shall thinke fitt shall enter into a
Bonde unto my said Overseers for the true payment of all those legacies and somes of moneye
devyded by this my will unto my said children and if that they doe refuse and will not enter into
suche Bonds wherby my children mighte be secured of their portions that then my will is
that vppon the refusynge to enter into suche Bonds and the intermarriage wth such a man
as shall so refuse that my Overseers presentlye vppon such refusal shall wholye and absolutely
deale & dispose of my said children and of their portions to the only use and profite of my
said children and for the better p^oformance of this my last will and testament And I doe
ordaine and appoynte my welbeloued wyfe my sole Executor to whom I give the rest of all

my Goodes.
